**Subject: Increasing Delegates - Women
and Youth**

FURTHER to Annual Assembly Resolution No. 1991-16 which resolved the establishment of a Mushkegowuk Women's Association and greater involvement of women as Mushkegowuk First Nations strive for self-government;

AND FURTHER to Annual Assembly Resolution No. 1989-113 which resolved that the Mushkegowuk Council would hire staff to deal with sexual equality issues;

AND FURTHER to Annual Assembly Resolution No. 1990-138 which resolved that a Youth Council and an Elder's Council would be established for the Mushkegowuk region;

AND WHEREAS the Mushkegowuk communities are in a process of restoring self-government in the Mushkegowuk region;

AND WHEREAS the active involvement of women, youth and elders can greatly contribute to the discussions and decisions which future assemblies will be making on behalf of the Mushkegowuk communities;
