and Board of Chiefs are directly
or indirectly refusing to
recognize the inherent right of
the Moose Factory First Nation to
apply jurisdiction within its
traditional land;

WHEREAS it is the position of the
Moose Factory First Nation that
this is contrary to the
principles of Mushkegowuk
Council's Constitution;
