Mushkegowuk member First Nations to learn
the Cree language;

WHEREAS the loss of our language is very
visible in some of our existing communities;

WHEREAS other First Nations within Canada
have faced the same problem and dealt with
the issue with great success;

WHEREAS a Cree immersion course of
several weeks, held in a Mushkegowuk
Council community, is a possible means of
promoting the Cree language, and a possible
economic development business venture;
