

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this acceptance and confirmation be effective as of the date of a Weenusk First Nation BCR confirming its membership in Mushkegowuk Council;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the other members of Mushkegowuk Council hereby express and wish to convey to the Weenusk First Nation their desire for and their anticipation of a mutually beneficial renewed relationship of co-operation and understanding with the people of the Weenusk First Nation.
