Mushkegowuk Territory Transportation Study

WHEREAS Mushkegowuk Council through Assembly Resolution 1995-10-09 endorsed a study to be undertaken to development the examine construction of an all season road to link the communities of Moosonee. Albany, Kashechewan and Attawapiskat Government's following the Ontario implementation of the Highway Traffic Act in the Mushkegowuk territory;

WHEREAS Mushkegowuk Council was able to secure financing to undertake and complete the initial study to conduct a needs assessment to confirm transportation options worthy of detailed exploration;

WHEREAS it is recommended by the delegates in Assembly that the findings of the Mushkegowuk Transportation Study be received and that the concept of an All Season Road between the communities from Attawapiskat to Moosonee with a connection to the south be endorsed for further study.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chiefs in Assembly mandates Mushkegowuk Council to secure funding required to advance the project to have a
