
SUBJECT: COMMUNITY BASED NATIVE TEACHER

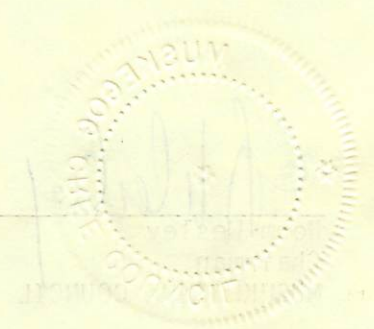
