AND WHEREAS the Department of Indian Affairs is attempting to apply a "priorization" formula to the schedule of construction of schools for First Nation students:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT very serious efforts be made to facilitate early completion of the feasibility study for the new school for the Fort Albany First Nation and that the final document be advanced to Treasury Board for approval to begin the construction phase immediately following completion of the feasibility study.
