WHEREAS direction was given under Resolution No. 1989-94 demanding that the practice of charging chronic care co-payments to Mushkegowuk First Nations be stopped immediately;


AND WHEREAS the former Ontario Ministry of Health made co-payment charges effective as of December 1984 so that illegal charges to our people over the last 5 1/2 years became legitimate;

AND WHEREAS Mr. Bob Rae, following his 1989 tour of the west coast of James Bay, stated in the Globe and Mail newspaper that our people are worse off than we were in 1955 due to the imposition of chronic care co-payments;

SUBJECT: CHRONIC CARE PAYMENTS

WHEREAS direction was given under section 1990-189
No. 1990-06 demanding that the practice of
providing chronic care co-payments to
membership families be stopped
immediately;

AND WHEREAS the former Office of
Health made co-payment practice a
part of its policy to stop all
out-benefit over the last 2 years because
it is ineffective;

AND WHEREAS Mr. Bob Bee, following the 1988
form of the new cost of living, especially
in the Gorge and Main newspaper after our
benefit rate more than we were in 1988
due to the imposition of chronic care co-
payments;

AND WHEREAS Mr. Bob Bee targets staffed trips
the weekend oflegislative lettercirculate was
announced;

AND WHEREAS the former provincial government
meant the new policy unacceptable to our
leadership;

THEFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the
Muskegomuk Council demands that Mr. Bob Bee
as premier-elect hold off his 1989 agenda

any other benefit who have been assigned
