AND WHEREAS the Mushkegowuk Council is working with the Government of Canada regarding the improved delivery of health care services and programs;


AND WHEREAS in the 1990-91 Regional Medical Services Branch Report it appears that as the province gains an interest in native health affairs, federal jurisdictional boundaries and resources for the provision of Indian health services may become an issue;

WHEREAS the Muskkegomuk Council adopted on  
our self Government bodies known as  
"Parishes in Council" in June 1980;

working with the Government of Canada  
regarding the transfer of certain  
civic services and programs;

AND WHEREAS in the 1980-81 Referendum  
Medicay Service Board is asked to decide  
what is the best service since no decision is  
possible without extensive, detailed information  
from government and commerce for the  
people in each;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the  
Muskkegomuk Council uses all acceptable means  
to express its position on the proposed  
transfer of certain civic functions  
of the Muskkegomuk Council with the understanding  
that the Muskkegomuk Council will be involved in the  
process;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Muskkegomuk  
Council notify the Government of Canada of  
our intent to monitor any changes to  
issues.
