THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chiefs in Assembly direct the Nishnawbe Aski Police Services to allocate the required resources to meet the demand for increased law enforcement activities and frequent patrols day and night (24 hours) on the winter access road between Moosonee and Attawapiskat;

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Chiefs in Assembly fully support the NAPS in securing the required financial resources from the provincial and federal governments to adequately meet the demand for increased policing services.
