Assessment of Impacts for Remediation of the Mid-Canada Line

WHEREAS the Mid-Canada Line was constructed the Mushkegowuk across Territory without the approval endorsement of the First Nations; and

WHEREAS the Mid-Canada Line was neglected by both the abandoned and governments of Ontario and Canada. causing significant and widespread harm to the lands, waters, wildlife and Peoples of the Mushkegowuk Territory; and

WHEREAS the Governments of Canada and Ontario are currently negotiating a costsharing agreement for remediation of the sites:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this Assembly for environmental calls an potentially significant assessment of associated negative impacts with remediation process including the transportation of PCB-contaminated waste over James and Hudson Bays to be completed prior to the undertaking of these activities;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that both the assessment process and final reports be reviewed by the Mushkegowuk Council of Chiefs, and any unresolved major concerns brought to the attention of the relevant community, all with the goal of having the project proceed safely and expeditiously.
